

WALDO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT SESSION (Emergency Session)
June 28, 2006

OLD BUSINESS: MAINE STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM ENROLLMENT CLARIFICATION:
****A. F. moved, J. Hyk seconded to clarify the eligibility for enrollment of Waldo County employees with the Maine State Retirement System plan effective July 1, 2006 as follows: All full-time employees and those part-time employees who are regularly scheduled to work a minimum of fifteen hours per week are eligible to enroll with the Maine State Retirement System plan effective July 1, 2006. Part-time employees who average fifteen hours of work per week but are not regularly scheduled to work a minimum of fifteen hours per week are not eligible to enroll with the Maine State Retirement plan effective July 1, 2006. Passed by two.**

NEW BUSINESS:

B. Arseneau read a recommendation from Sheriff Scott Story promoting Deputy Matthew Curtis to the rank of Detective at the Waldo County Sheriff's Office with a pay increase from \$15.94 to \$17.60 per hour, effective July 2, 2006.

****A. Fowler moved, J. Hyk seconded approving the promotion of Deputy Matthew Curtis to Detective at a rate of \$17.60 per hour effective July 2, 2006. Passed by two.**

****G. Boetsch moved, A. Fowler seconded adjourning the meeting at 8:17 a.m. Unanimous.**
