

**WALDO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT SESSION  
(SPECIAL SESSION)  
APRIL 14, 2010**

**PRESENT:** Commissioners Amy R. Fowler and William D. Shorey, EMA Director Dale Rowley and County Clerk Barbara L. Arseneau.

A. Fowler called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:**

**\*\*A. Fowler moved, W. Shorey seconded to enter Executive Session according to M.R.S.A. Title 1 § 405 (C) for a legal matter. Passed unanimously by two.**

**\*\*A. Fowler moved, W. Shorey seconded to come out of Executive Session at 4:47 P.M. Passed unanimously by two.**

**\*\*A. Fowler moved, W. Shorey seconded that, after careful consideration, the County Commissioners have weighed out their options as to what to do with the current Sheriff's Office and Old Jail piece once the new Public Safety Building is finished, and have decided to rescind their vote taken on February 24, 2010 to put the Sheriff's Office on the market as a residential home. The County is so cramped for space that it is to the County's benefit to retain these buildings and apply for some grant monies to renovate these buildings to create much needed office space the County so desperately lacks. Passed unanimously by two.**

**SHERIFF'S CORRESPONDENCE:**

1. The Sheriff sent written notice that he is in the process of policy review for the entire patrol division. He said that he would assume that the Commissioners would not want to review these as most of the updates are "minutia" but if they did wish to review them, to please let him know.

2. The Sheriff requested that he be authorized to replace portable radios that are over fifteen years old by purchasing new ones from Asset Forfeiture funds for an amount not to exceed \$1,500.00.

3. The Sheriff, after reviewing some of the Community Corrections needs and speaking with Volunteers of America Program Director Michael Tausek, felt that the Re-entry Center could use more literacy and volunteer work for educational advancement as well as parenting skills development. Both of those items come to the center from Broadreach in Belfast. The Sheriff is in the process of working with them to further those services and requested authorization from the Commissioners to expend some of the Community Corrections funds to accomplish this, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00 for the two aforementioned services combined.

**\*\*W. Shorey moved, A. Fowler seconded to approve the requests by the Sheriff as presented. Passed unanimously by two.**

**\*\*A. Fowler moved, W. Shorey seconded to exit the meeting at 4:55 P.M. Passed unanimously by two.**
