<b>Evacuations</b>	None at this time.
<b>Shelter-In-Place</b>	None at this time.
<b>Power Outage Status (CHANGE)</b>	30% of County is without power. CMP has brought in many additional crews from out-of-state.
<b>Road Closed</b>	Most roads have been reopened. A few back roads may still be blocked so drive with care. If a road is not opened it is probably due to the tree debris touching the powerlines and still not safe to touch. It will remain until the lines are removed by CMP.
<b>Weather Brief (CHANGE)</b>	<b>Tonight:</b> A 30 percent chance of rain before 7pm. Cloudy, with a low around 55. South wind around 10 mph. <b>Friday:</b> A 50 percent chance of showers after 8am. Cloudy, with a high near 61. South wind around 10 mph. New precipitation amounts of less than a tenth of an inch possible. <b>Friday Night:</b> Mostly clear, with a low around 37. Northwest wind around 10 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph.
<b>Shelters (CHANGE)</b>	The closest Red Cross Shelter is located at the Augusta Auditorium. This is a Pet Friendly Shelter. There is no public transportation available to go to Augusta.
<b>Warming Centers</b>	1) Islesboro Community Center 2) Liberty Fire Station 3) Stockton Springs Town Office (business hours) – recharging only.
<b>Mass Feeding Sites</b>	None Available at this Time.
<b>Other News</b>	Be aware that some gas stations do not have power and are unable to pump gas. You may want to call your local gas stations to determine if they are able to provide fuel.
