TEMPORARY / FULL TIME Patrol Deputy

The Waldo County Sheriff's Office is seeking a dynamic, qualified applicant for a TEMPORARY / FULL TIME Patrol Deputy. Ideal candidates will possess a strong community policing mindset to complement their law enforcement experience. This position will be full time for up to three (3) years to help augment current patrol activities and fill vacancies created by military commitments of current Waldo County Sheriff's Office Deputies.

Applicants must, at a minimum, possess a High School Diploma/GED and a valid Maine Driver's License or the ability to obtain one. Applicants must have successfully passed the Maine Criminal Justice Academy ALERT and Physical Agility Test. Successful candidates will need to pass a comprehensive background investigation, oral board interview, psychological, medical and polygraph examinations.

The Waldo County Sheriff's Office offers competitive wage and benefit packages including Maine State Retirement plan 2C (25yrs service, 50% salary) currently, Plan 3C (25yrs service, 66% salary) beginning January 1, 2020. Take home cruiser, health, dental, vision insurances all available. Credit for FULL TIME law enforcement experience and starting pay step are negotiable based upon previous experience.

Waldo County Sheriff's Deputies are represented by the Fraternal Order of Police, local lodge 1-7, a copy of the current collective bargaining unit agreement is available for inspection upon request.

The Waldo County Sheriff's Office maintains a residency requirement in which Deputies must live within five drivable miles of the Waldo County line.
